

ORDINANCE NO. 3, 1962

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE STORAGE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY ON PORT FLOATS OR DOCKS OWNED BY THE PORT OF NEWPORT WITHOUT WRITTEN CONSENT AND THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF NEWPORT:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for anyone to use the floats or docks owned by the Port of Newport for the storage of personal property without first obtaining the written consent of an authorized representative of the Port of Newport.

SECTION 2. "Storage" as defined in this ordinance shall mean the leaving of personal property on the floats or docks owned by the Port of Newport for more than one hour.

SECTION 3. Violation of this ordinance is punishable by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00, or by imprisonment in the county jail for not less than one day nor more than ten days, or both.

SECTION 5. The Board of Commissioners hereby declare this to be an emergency ordinance and shall be effective immediately upon passage.
