

ORDINANCE NO. 3, 1968

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ON PORT PROPERTY IN DEPOE BAY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PORT OF NEWPORT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to park or deposit any personal property on any real property owned by the Port of Newport in the area of Depoe Bay, Oregon, by any person, firm or corporation unless such person, firm or corporation has previously contracted with the Port for moorage facilities and is in good standing on said contract.

Section 2. Anyone in violation of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, be fined not to exceed \$50.00 or confined in jail not to exceed 10 days or by both such fine and imprisonment and not to exceed the maximums herein set forth.

Section 3. WHEREAS an emergency is hereby deemed to exist, and it is declared necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Lincoln County, Oregon, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

This Ordinance is declared adopted this 14th day of October, 1968.
