ORDINANCE NO. 2-1982

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2-1979 RESTRICTING FISHING AND CRABBING ON PORT OF NEWPORT PROPERTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Port of Newport has enacted Ordinances relating to the regulation of Port-owned and managed facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.6 of Ordinance No. 1-1974 and Ordinance No. 2-1979 prescribe limits regarding fishing and crabbing from the walkways, wharves, docks, barges and piers which are owned, managed or otherwise within the control of the Port of Newport; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of the Port of Newport finds that for reasons of safety, security, and the well-being of the patrons of the Port of Newport Commercial Boat Marina, such fishing and crabbing activities in the Port Dock Seven area are not in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Port of Newport ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2-1979 is hereby amended to further amend Subsection 3.6 of Ordinance No. 1-1974 to add the following paragraph after Paragraph 3.6(2):

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) above, no person shall fish or crab from Port Dock Seven at any time.

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
