

PORT OF NEWPORT
ORDINANCE NO. 2-1979

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING FISHING AND CRABBING ON PORT OF NEWPORT PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Port of Newport has enacted various and sundry ordinances relating to the regulation of Port facilities;

WHEREAS, Section 3.6 of Ordinance No. 1-1974 presently permits fishing and crabbing from the walkways, wharves, docks, barges and piers during daylight hours; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Newport Commissioners find that use of Port Dock Five for such fishing and crabbing activities is not in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PORT OF NEWPORT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection 3.6 of Ordinance No. 1-1974 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.6. Fishing and Crabbing.

(1) No person shall fish, crab or engage in similar such activity on, about or from the walkways, wharves, docks, barges, piers or other property of the Port of Newport except during the hours of daylight, from one hour before sunrise to one hour after sunset. Any person engaging in such activity shall promptly remove all equipment, gear or paraphernalia from said facility during the hours of darkness.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) above, no person shall fish or crab from Port Dock Five at any time.

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
