INCLUDING SLEEPING PORT OF NEWPORT SELF PROPELCED JEHICLES ORDINANCE NO. 1 - 1971 N ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF GAMPERS FOR LIVING PURPOSES WHILE PARKED ON PORT OF NEWPORT PROPERTY: PROHIBIGING PARKING OF HOUSE TRAILERS ON PORT OF NEWPORT PROPERTY; ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. BE IT ORDANNED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT OF NEWPORT, NEWPORT, OREGON AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. The use of campers for living purposes, including cooking and sleeping, while parked on property owned or controlled by the Port of Newport, Newport, Oregon is forbidden, and Section 2. Parking of House Trailers on property owned or controlled by the Port of Newport is prohibited, and Section 3. Any person convicted of violating this ordinance whall be punished by a fine of not to exceed twenty-five dollars or by imprisonment for not to exceed five days or by both such fine and imprisonment, and Section 4. It is hereby determined that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, the refore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
