PORT OF NEWPORT ORDINANCE NO. 2 1967

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS FOR THE PORT OF NEWPORT OF PROPERTY OWNED BY MARGUERITE HAYDON, FORMERLY MARGUERITE CHATTERTON.

THE PORT OF NEWPORT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Port of Newport hereby declares it necessary and convenient in carrying on its work and/or exercising, carrying out and executing any of its powers provided in ORS 777.050 and 777.105 to 777.130 to be carried on, exercised, carried out or executed by the Port to exercise its power of eminent domain as granted by ORS 777.115 and pertinent related statutes of the State of Oregon and to condemn the following property now owned by Marguerite Haydon, also known as Marguerite Chatterton.

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, Block 4, Olson's 2nd. Addition lying and being above the mean high water line of the Yaquina Bay, Lincoln County, Oregon.

Section 2. The necessity for the exercise of this authority is based upon the necessity of providing drainage of surface water and to provide suitable areas for future development of the Port of Newport.

Section 3. The attorney for the Port of Newport is authorized, empowered and directed to proceed with the preparation, filing and prosecution of such legal action as may be required to accomplish said condemnation and the President of the Port of Newport is authorized, empowered and directed to execute any complaints or other documents in the name of the Port of Newport as prepared by the attorney for the Port in such proceedings.

This Ordinance is declared adopted in special session this 25th day of October, 1967.
