## PORT OF NEWPORT

## ORDINANCE NO. 1-1981

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING AT THE PORT OF NEWPORT, PROHIBITING CAMPING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

- Section 1. DEFINITIONS

  A. "Manager". The manager of the Port of Newport, or his agent, or any person designated by the Board of Port Commissioners for the purposes of this ordinance.
- B. "Park". To place or leave any vehicle, trailer or boat on land within the boundaries of the Port of Newport.
  - C. "Port". The Port of Newport.
- Section 2. Parking is allowed at the Port only in areas designated by the manager. Parking is expressly prohibited in driveways, areas which have been designated as "no parking areas" or any other area except areas designated for parking.
- Section 3. No motor vehicle, trailer or boat shall be parked at the Port for a period exceeding 72 hours unless authorized by the manager.
- Section 4. Notwithstanding Section 3 above, no motor vehicle, trailer or boat shall be parked on Dock 5 for a period exceeding 15 minutes without the express, written consent of such manager, specifying the date and time such parking shall be permitted to occur in excess of said 15 minute time limit.
- Section 5. No person shall repair or dismantle any motor vehicle, trailer or boat that is parked at the Port, except with the express written consent of the manager.
- Section 6. No person shall remain in or occupy any motor vehicle, trailer or boat parked at the Port between the hours of 10:00 o'clock P.M. and 4:00 o'clock A.M. This shall not prohibit occupancy of vessels moored in authorized moorage spaces, however.
- Section 7. Camping is prohibited on Port property.
- Section 8. Any person causing or permitting a boat, trailer or other vehicle to be parked contrary to the provisions hereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00, or imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, or both. Each day such violation shall continue shall constitute a separate offense hereunder. The owner thereof shall be deemed to have permitted any boat, trailer or other vehicle to be parked unlawfully, unless such owner shall affirmatively show that the same was used by and in the control of another without the owner's consent, express or implied. Any boat, trailer or vehicle parked in violation hereof may be towed at the expense of the owner thereof in the manner as provided by ORS 98.805 to 98.818.

Section 9. This ordinance is determined hereby to be necessary for the health, safety, peace, protection and welfare of the Port of Newport, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
